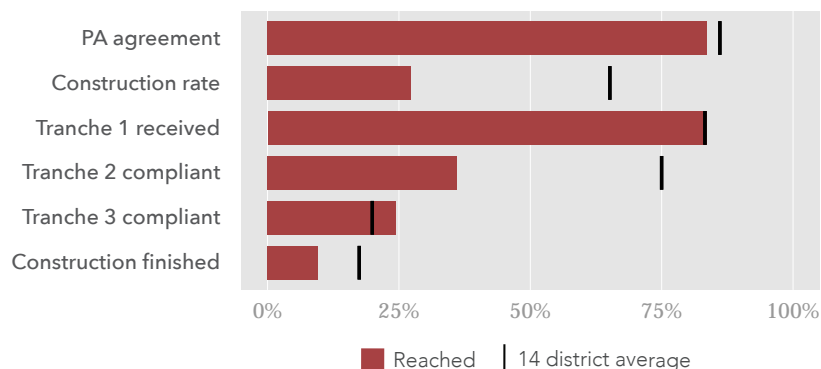


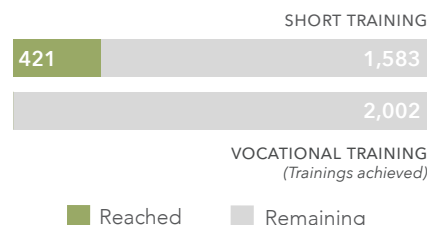

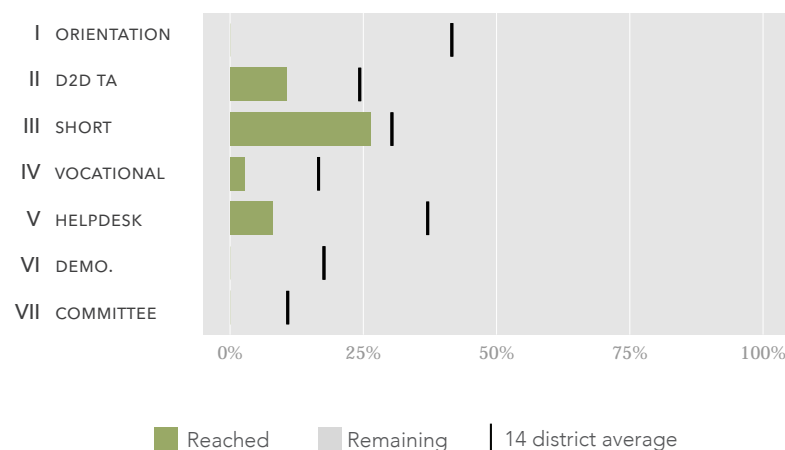

#### Core Socio-technical Assistance Activities\* (% of VDCs)



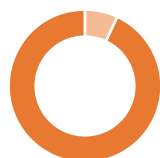

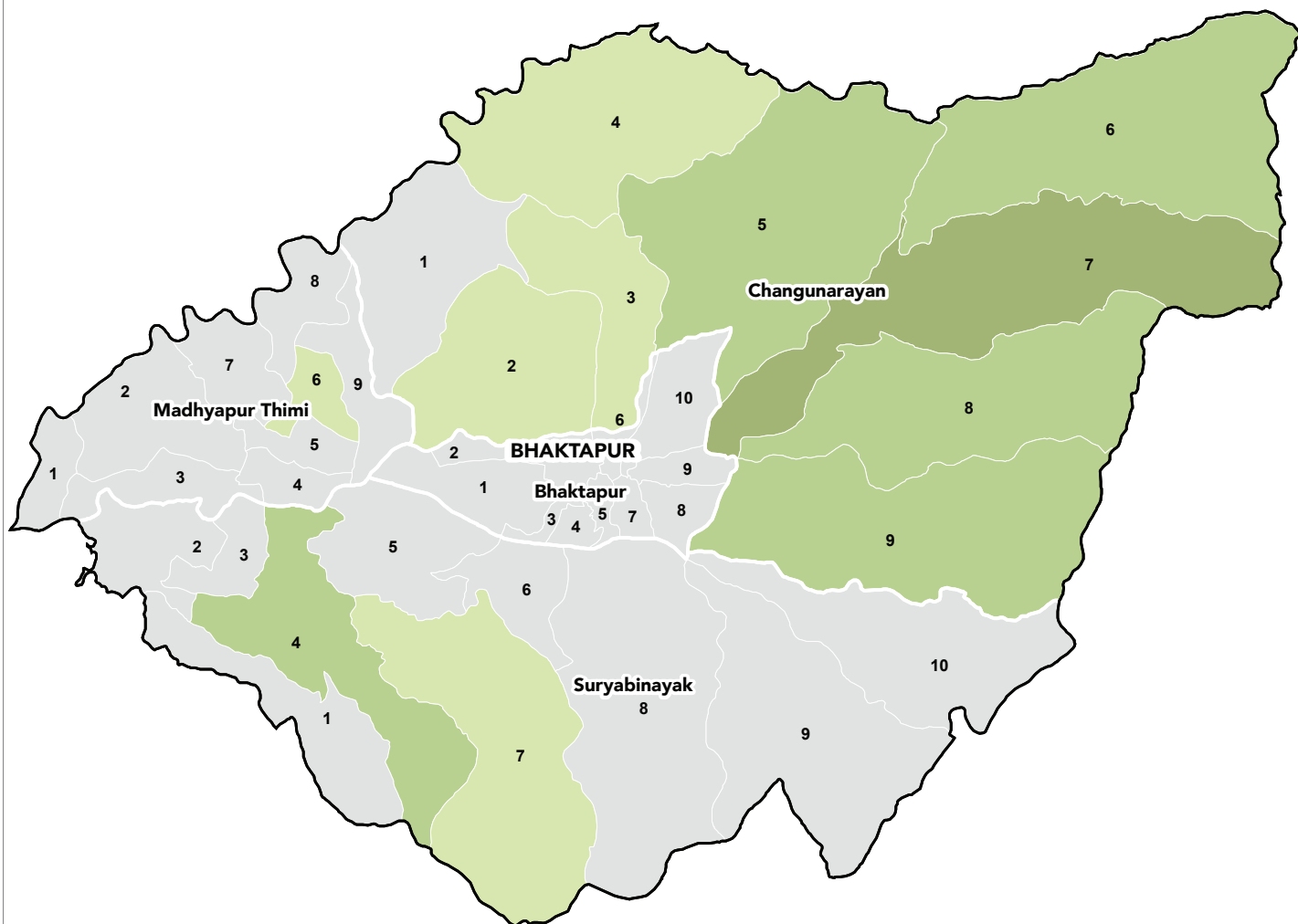
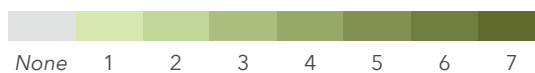
