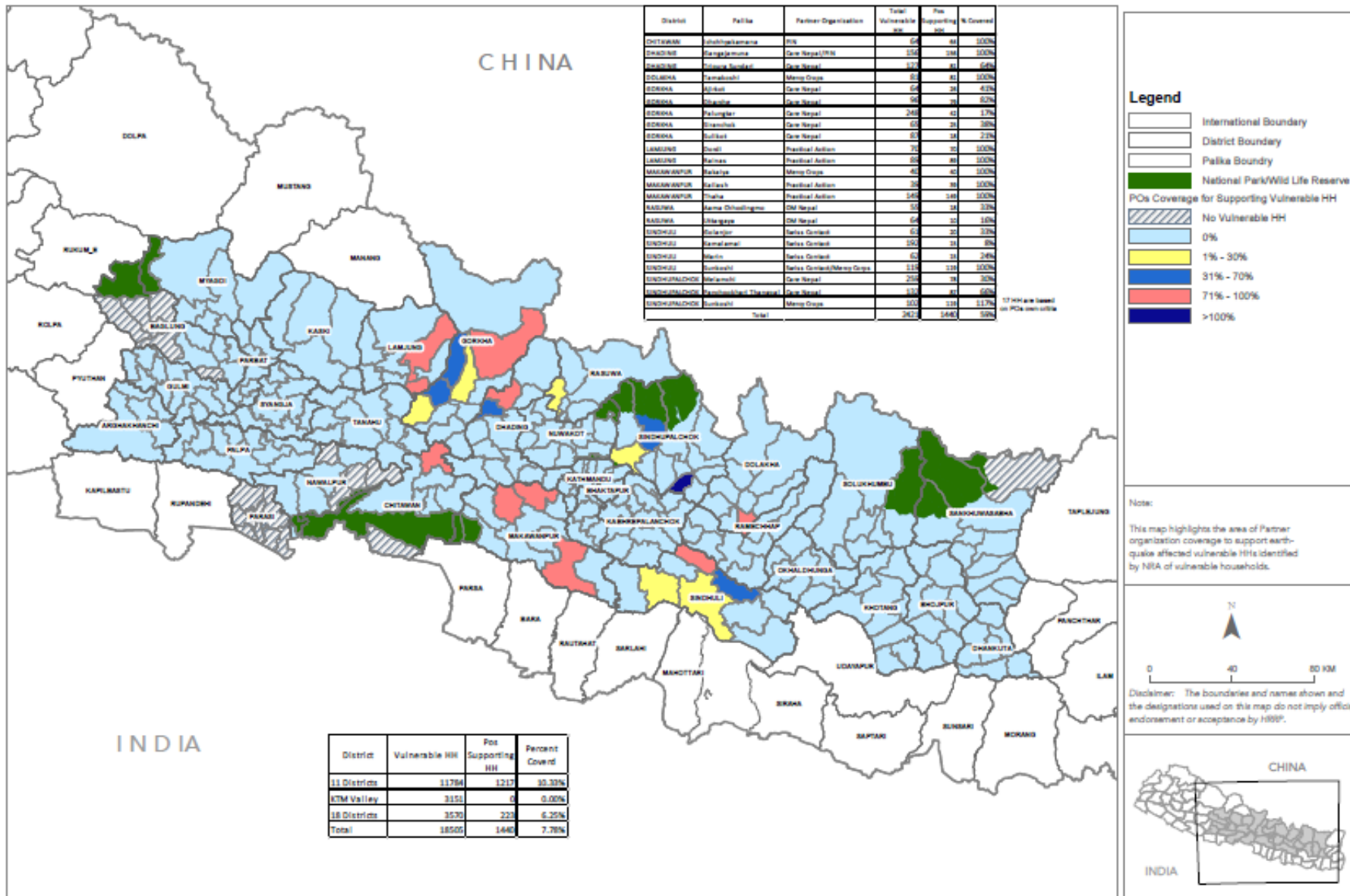

# Vulnerable Support Projects Submitted to NRA



- 6 POs projects submitted and under review
  - Average cost per HH / month (total) = 332 USD
  - Average cost per HH / month (STA only) = 305 USD
  - Range = 38 USD – 910 USD
  - NSET Baliyo Ghar STA costs 240 NPRs per HH / month
  - JICA Community Mobilisation Programme costs 570 NPRs per HH / month
- Fragmentation and projectisation – no common strategy, approach, or scale
- Leaving gaps and risk of duplication



# Vulnerable Support Projects Submitted to NRA



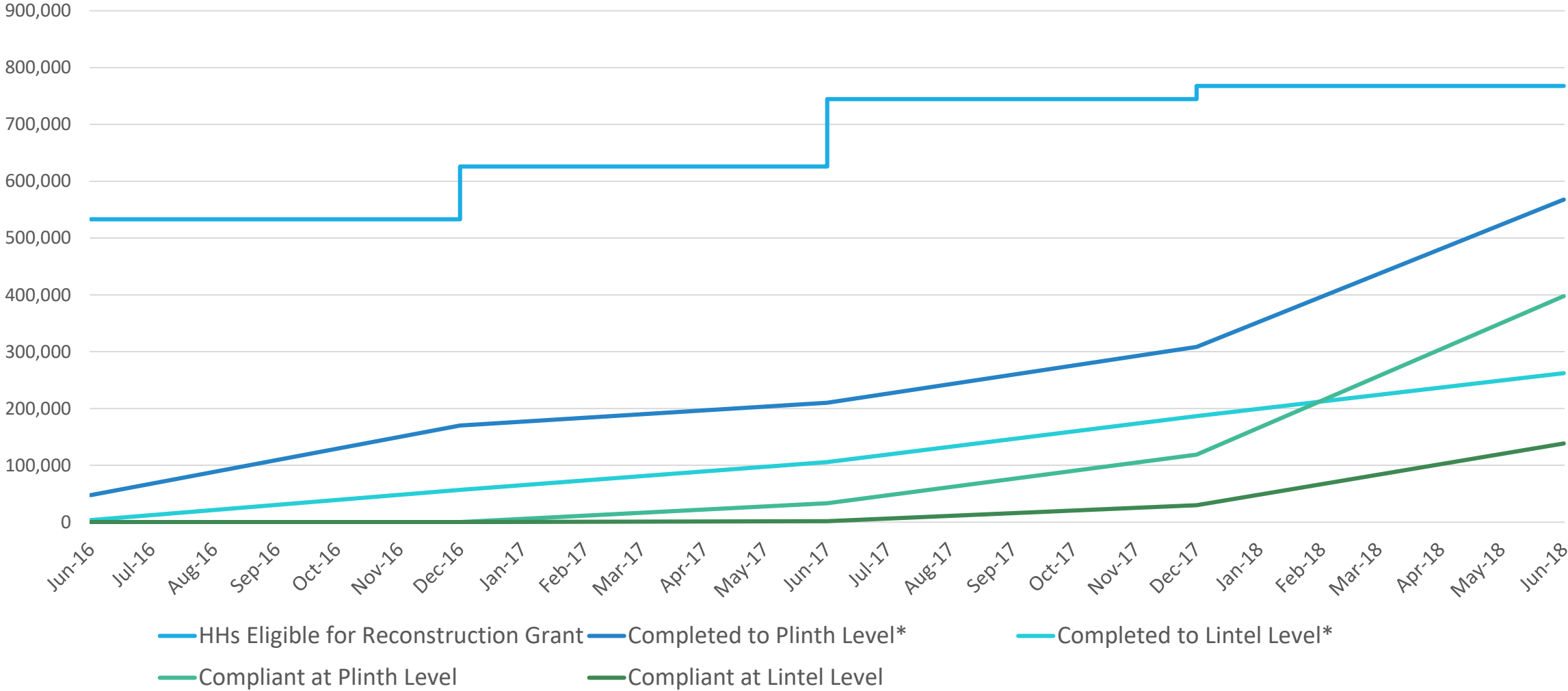
- 6.14 million USD committed but only covers 7.78% of total 18,505 HHs identified as vulnerable by NRA
- As of 24 June, 612,207 HHs need support to get to 3<sup>rd</sup> tranche (N.B. 3<sup>rd</sup> tranche does not equal completion)

# Vulnerable List Status Assessment



- 1,329 HHs checked – HRRP DCTs
  - Completed construction – 28%
  - Stopped – 2%
  - Not started – 45%
  - Under construction – 26%
  
- POs
  - Sindhupalchok and Gorkha – 72.5% of list have started construction, 31.3% have completed
  - Rasuwa – 85% have started, 14% have received 3<sup>rd</sup> tranche, 52% have received 2<sup>nd</sup> tranche
  - Okhaldhunga – 65% have started, 20% have received 3<sup>rd</sup> tranche
