1. Personnel Changes

2. General Updates and Information

- The NRA executive committee recently finalised the **Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)** for the inspection process linked to housing grant disbursement. The SOP and associated forms (such as the compliance checklist) are expected to be released in the coming days and we are working to organise an orientation session on this to be held soon. We will keep you informed as we find out more.
- A meeting of the Strategic Advisory Group (SAG) was held on Tuesday 25 Oct. Minutes will be shared soon. If your organisation is interested to be part of the SAG please feel free to contact Loren. The Platform is particularly keen to have a higher number of local NGOs represented in the SAG.
- In his new role, Loren met this week with a range of actors; including the NRA, World Bank, NSET, and POs in order to better understand the priorities of all stakeholders. A planning meeting of the full HRRP staff (District and National Level) is being held today (28 Oct). Minutes and outcomes will be shared soon with all members.
- An 'introduction pack' will be made available on the HRRP website next week, including essential policy documents and links related to the housing reconstruction programme.
