Finally, in their own House

22 landless Families in Ilaka number 6 of okhaldhunga has got their own house. United Mission to Nepal (UMN) one of the partner organization working under the health sector from more than 50 years in the district has recently completed 22 houses from their first phase program under the (DRR) Disaster Risk Reduction program. After the 2015 Earth Quake all the victim got something from the government but the landless didn't get any think as they were living in the landlords house to take care of their property and after the earth quake the house was damaged and they were in worst condition.in that case UMN came up with the DRR program in okhaldhunga to help those landless people and started survey from Ilika no 6 of okhaldhunga which include Rawadolu,Bhusunga,Khijichandeswori,Khijifalate,khijikatiand Ragani one of the most remort area in the wester and northen part of okhaldhunga and found 22 such house who were really in miserable condition. During the project period UMN coordinated with government ,local government and the local political parties and for providing land to those landless families in free or very minimum cost and then all the financial and the technical support was provided by the United Mission to Nepal.
