<b>Objective</b>	To conduct survey on temporary shelter, woman beneficiary, woman mason and CRC.	
<b>Summary</b>	As plan and scheduled by HRRP, we prepared a plan to start the survey from 27 <sup>th</sup> Feb in Sindhupalchok district. We divided in two groups among us as 2 from national team were with us to support in the district. In coordination with POs and DLPIU engineers, SM we completed it more than 50% of field survey. We found many beneficiaries are living in temporary shelters whose house is under construction. Few of those were single women and have not started reconstruction yet. For example, out of 7 temporary shelters, 3 were of single women and elderly as well in a VDC (Syaule).

A Single elderly woman is helpless on reconstruct her house. Her previous house was completely damaged and now living in a temporary CGIs shelter in the side of her younger sisters' temporary shelter in Syaule VDC/Chautara Sangachokgadhi N.P. ward no 1. She is living alone since her husband died and daughters got married, she has not son.



During an interview/survey of woman beneficiary and temporary shelter in front of her T shelter. She lives in the side of her younger sisters' T shelters. Both sisters are single woman beneficiaries. Both have not started reconstruction though they had received I tranche in the beginning.
