Tranche Status: First Tranche
Housing Structure: **Mud bag** house.
These houses are constructed immediately after emergency relief. There are 18 houses with new techniques of housing with mud bag and already completed but they have not got 2nd and 3rd tranche. They are in the process of getting tranches.
Methodology of making mud bag:
Locally available mud and sand are mixed in certain proportion and packed in a plastic bag.



Location: Gerkhutar, Bidur 10
This house is made up of hollow concrete block with 2 rooms but DSE Mr.Saurv said that this is not under compliance due to insufficient vertical reinforcement. Beneficiary is complaining that technical engineers are not coming in right time to inspect.
