## Case Study

### Desire to support in building earthquake resilient homes

Sukule Lama (36), from Gogane 9, Pakani Makwanpur is the sole breadwinner for a family of Four, his wife and two children (One daughter of age 18 and a son of age 14 ) as his wife is busy engaged as housewife and help in agriculture activities of him. His wife also has an added responsibility of taking care of their son and daughter as he get busy engaged in Earning outside for hand to mouth.

Prior to April 25 earthquake, Mr. Lama had been earning Nepalese rupees 350 a day working as an unskilled mason, Garment Business, Biogas etc. . He have to get engaged in those works as the food produced from his land (about 2.5 Gatha )is not enough . Those lands are not his own. Land is None registered and is of Government. However, after the quake, his life changed as it was difficult for him to find works as people in his village now he got engaged as master Mason in Build change .Build change assist technically to build Private house in Gogane. He earns 45 Thousand monthly to adjust his living expenses from there.

“I was worried about how to earn living for my family as it was hard for unskilled person in getting job of building earthquake resilient houses. When I heard about training on building earthquake resilient homes offered by Build change , Assisted by Nepal Red Cross Society and funded by American Red cross for Reconstruction and Cooperation from my friend, my happiness knew no bound. Immediately applied for training with a hope of getting employment, better payment and gaining added skills of building earthquake resilient homes,” said Lama.

Now, he has taken 7-days on-site Mason training. He is hopeful that he will get job in construction projects with better payment even after the reconstruction activities stops here at Gogane.

Mr. Lama hopes that he will be able get at least Rs 1,000 a day after training as building earthquake resilient homes is an urgent need of Makwanpur district.

He also expressed his desire to contribute for construction process after completion of the Reconstruction program in Gogane. Nevertheless, he has plan to build own house after earning money in a year or so.

“I am very satisfied with the way we are being taught as its very practical and easy for uneducated people like us to understand. I will contribute in building earthquake resilient homes in my district. I am very happy to be able to contribute in reconstruction process,” said Mr. Lama.

He suggests others not to stay idle rather learn something. “Once you have skills in hand, you do not have to depend on others. Life becomes easy and the way others look at you changes.”
