Summary	<p>Since the field visit is the regular HRRP task to highlight the issues and sharing the best practice, HRRP team went to Bhedabari, Panchakanya – 05. There are 500 beneficiaries and Almost all of them have started building houses however, few beneficiaries has not taken even first tranche. Some of them are not listed in the published NRA beneficiary list and some of them are tried in grievance. They are showing their major concerns on late release of 2nd tranche however, they have applied 2 months ago. They are starting to build house by taking loan from relatives and friend due to poor life style. Mercy Cops has made one demo house (Co-operative buildings) in Bhedabari and they believe that this building is the earthquake resilience so that beneficiaries can take reference to build their house.</p>

As HRRP also talked with Ward chair, he said that his name was missing earlier and now registered as grievance so that he will get first tranche probably within 2 months.

Ms. Maiya Nepali, 84 years old woman is still staying in shelter along with her husband. She is still expecting to have own home to stay. They look poor family so that their younger son helps her to made DPC of one room home to claim government grant. He dream is to staying in new home.
