Summary	<p>Field Visit was conducted in these two VDC and during the visit palika level meeting was also conducted in the chairmanship of vice chairman of the palika. during the meeting various challenges in the VDC were discussed and identified.</p> <p>Different ward leaders gave their views regarding reconstruction and put their quarries with the NRA chief and the NRA chief tried to give the possible solution of their challenges.</p>

Housing Typology Report



Ward 3, Chishankhu Gadhi Rural municipality, Okhaldhunga: Dhanapati Dhungana is the house owner. He has only received the first tranche and forwarded the file for the second tranche. The stone masonry structure in mud mortar is in progress of rapid construction, some problem on transportation of materials and scarcity of the labor are the main obstacles for the construction said mr. Dhungana.



Ward 3, Chishankhu Gadhi Rural municipality, Okhaldhunga : House owner is Dhruyodhan Karki. He has received third tranche. The stone masonry structure with wooden band is the first house constructed in this ward. Mr.Karki is happy with the technical monitoring and guidance provided by the NRA engineer. Only he is afraid on how to protect the wooden band from water and termite. We suggest him to use enamel paints or black tar.



Ward 3, Chishankhu Gadhi Rural municipality, Okhaldhunga: The owner of the house Govinda Parsad Dhungana. The house is almost completed the construction procedure and eligible for the third tranche but he could not even receive second tranche. We asked him why he did not receive the second tranche yet, he said that there is problem in PA number and the name corresponding to the Pa number. The second tranche of Dhungana is transferred to the person Sher bahadur magar who is not a respondent beneficiary to receive the Tranche. Knowing all the problem we transferred this problem to NRA Oghaldhunga for further help



Ward 3, Chishankhu Gadhi Rural municipality, Okhaldhunga: Harka Bahadur Magar is the house owner. He has received Second tranche. The stone masonry structure in mud mortar is in progress of completion and only the roof band is remaining before placing the roof.
