- The **MoUD-CLPIU MIS portal** [here](#) provides a district overview of **inspection and reconstruction progress** based on DLPIU engineers reports. It shows that across 14 districts, 31,350 houses have started reconstruction, 626 houses weren't reconstructed as per the Building Code and were not certified for the 2<sup>nd</sup> tranche and 88 houses were approved for the 2<sup>nd</sup> tranche.
