Mainly the people of tipling vdc used to construct one story house with maximum two room, Dry stone masonry wall, Wooden Band, Wooden roofing or CGI sheet roofing, Wood Planking in flooring etc. The house constructed in tipling vdc is maximum earthquake resilient and Complaints.
