• The HRRP has revised the 4W template and the first round of data collection using this template is now complete. We are pleased to share a number of maps in the 'Information Products' section of this bulletin, which have been developed based on the 4W data. These show that only 14 VDCs out of a total 619 are receiving the full package of Technical Assistance (TA) support required. If quality TA is not provided at scale across the earthquake affected areas, households will find it very difficult to effectively utilise the Government of Nepal Housing Grant as well as their own investment, to rebuild a compliant house. We have a joint responsibility to work together to address this, and the HRRP strongly urges all POs to seriously look at expanding their programmes to cover gaps, especially where they are not covering all wards in the working VDCs, to avoid duplications, and to improve the quality of programmes by ensuring that the full TA package is being delivered. • JICA have very kindly made available to all partners, the **refresher training package** that they have developed for existing masons that have completed the 7 day training package. These training materials are available here. We would request that if you use this training package, you inform HRRP of the location in which the training was carried out so that we can share this with JICA. This training package has been developed as a follow up to JICA's survey on masons construction practices after training. HRRP would really appreciate partner support to carry out this survey to gain a better understanding of the impact of training across the districts. Meetings and Events

- District orientations for Partner Organisations (POs) on the Inspection SOP have now been completed in Dhading, Nuwakot, Dolakha, Kavre, Gorkha, Rasuwa, and Makwanpur. Many thanks to all the participants in these orientations. The orientation is scheduled for the 10 January in Sindhupalchowk and 11 January in Okhaldhunga. - On the 9 and 10 January, Practical Action will be carrying out a planning and orientation session for supply chain assessment in Gorkha. We are hoping to organise a similar process across all district, except for Nuwakot and Rasuwa where the assessment has been completed, and the HRRP District Coordinators will be engaging with partners on this over the coming weeks.
