

Reconstruction Community Based Committees Directive, 2073

- To increase the participation and ownership of the reconstruction works NRA has developed Reconstruction Community Based Committees Directive 2073.
- Reconstruction Community based committee is the committee formed for reconstruction and rehabilitation of the structures affected by earthquake in the settlements of VDC and Municipalities.
- The RCBC will have
 - One president (Selected from the Settlement)
 - Five members including three females
 - One member secretary
- The members will have a tenure of one year. Every year after the end of the fiscal year, the members should be renewed or new must be selected.
- Total number of the committees will be based on the number of settlement quoted by local bodies. The local body can formulate a necessary standard for that purpose.
- Roles and Responsibility:
 - For the mutual help among the community people in the settlements for the reconstruction after earthquake
 - The committees will suggest the reconstruction co-ordination committee in the VDC regarding the grievance about reconstruction.
 - To support households to work mutually with each other and to support different organizations working in the ward and community level.
 - The committees will co-ordinate with the local bodies and other stakeholders for institutional development, capacity development and other activities regarding financial and social prosperity
 - The committee will support VDC secretary, municipality executive officer and technical persons.
 - The committee will also support for PA signing, and grant distribution
 - The support for the formulation of the Integrated Reconstruction and Recovery Planning and co-ordination with the political party and bringing consensus among them is also one of the role of the committee.

Reconstruction Co-ordination Committee:

- Reconstruction Co-ordination Committee is formulated in the VDC and Municipalities to coordinate the activities regarding reconstruction and rehabilitation.
- The RCC will have :
 - Co-ordinator
 - Two to six members from RCBC including one to four female
 - Two from WCF including one female as members
 - Two from CAC including one female as members
 - Officer from local body as Secretary

- The members will have a tenure of one year. Every year after the end of the fiscal year, the members should be renewed or new must be selected.
- The committee must have a meeting up to three times a year.
- The roles and responsibilities of RCC are:
 - Co-ordinate and Facilitate the Reconstruction and rehabilitation of earthquake affected structures.
 - Support Local bodies for the Participation Agreement.
 - The support for the formulation of the Integrated Reconstruction and Recovery Planning and co-ordination with the political party
 - Co-ordination with the political party and bringing consensus
 - To find out the real situation of the beneficiary identification and grievance issues.
 - Inform local bodies find out the real situation if any complaints are registered regarding grants and other support.
 - Coordinate and facilitate the social mobilisers.
 - To solve the any problems during reconstruction program.

- **Property and liability**
 - The committees must use the property for the assigned purpose only.

- **Registration and Listing:**
 - The committees must be registered in the concerned VDC/ Municipality.
