Out of 56 a total of 8 household survey of Temporary Shelter and a total of 5 women experience in reconstruction mason was completed in the first day of field visit in kabu village. Still people are in Temporary shelter because they just started their reconstruction work and some of them have not started due to lack of people and skilled labor.</p> | | |

On 8th March 2018 HRRP team and NRA Engineer visited ward no -3, kashthali village of Umakunda Rural Municipality for data collection of women experience in reconstruction and to identify the issue and challenges in reconstruction. A total of 10 women experience reconstruction i.e. mason and a total of 5 women experience beneficiaries were interviewed for the survey. Only few women masons are involved in the reconstruction work in state trained Women Manson from different organization. Those who are involved in the reconstruction work as a mason they are still wanting for the refresh training and other vocational training.

Summary

On 9th March 2018 HRRP team and NRA Engineer visited Preeti Village of Umakunda Rural Municipality with purpose to conduct meeting with Palika members and survey for upcoming 3rd anniversary of April earthquake 2015. At 8 am in the morning we meet ward chairperson Mr. Sunwar and have short tea meeting. In the meeting we discussed about the purpose of our visit. Likewise, we discussed about the status of women mason in the village and reconstruction status of the ward. At 11 am we successfully completed the meeting with Rural Municipality of Umakunda. In the meeting the issues collected from the ward level were discussed in the Rural Municipality level with the Rural Municipality chairperson, Vice chairperson and the ward chairperson. Some forms were generated by joint efforts of HRRP district team and M&E consultant to overview the reconstruction status of ward, was distributed to the ward chairperson of all ward and were requested to send the filled form by the end of Falgun. The

form will be shared on the google drive. The following points are discussion in the meeting is as below:

- Mr. Tulsi Ram Lamichane technical Coordinator presented the format and make understand to the ward chairperson for data collection regarding the status of Rural Municipal in reconstruction.
- Mr. Roshan Kumar Yadav NRA Engineer requested them to identify and recommended to district about the vulnerable settlement. There is new provision to support Rs. Up to 200,000 for purchase new land in save place.
- Discussion on trained women mason in the rural municipal regarding what they are doing right now. Mr. Sher Bahadur Sunwar Chairperson of Umakunda municipality said that only few trained women are found in the reconstruction work. Remaining mason women are not in any contact, some of them have been migrated to aboard for employment.
- Some ward chairperson concerned regarding the grievance. Mr. Roshan Kumar Yadav NRA Engineer said that perhaps with in the week list of grievance will arrived in respective VDC for further reference.
